I have the same old Magma, and it doesn't require any drivers.

I'd try booting Windows XP with no EDS cards in, then one, then two, etc., until you can find the problem. If it is the bridge chips in the Magma, I believe Windows would fail even if no cards were in it. You may want to test it with another PCI card in it just in case I'm wrong about that. It sounds to me like a bad card that is throwing the PARIS driver for a shit when it tries to initialize any 442s that are attached (that happens on start up).
