Samplitude 8 does have PDC.

I have Sequoia 8 coming later this week or next and will run more thorough tests with it. I want to find out why it seems to be limited to a marginal bump in plugin counts (VST, not VSTi) even at higher latency/VIP buffer settings (assuming I am interpreting their affect on resources, and interaction with ASIO buffers correctly).

However, for what you are doing, Sam would probably be a 2X increase in plugin counts at 1.5ms over SX 3.x, maybe more (assuming SX has the same apparent limitation as Nuendo 3.x). I would suggest trying the Samplitude 8.11 demo to see if it will run I/O through plugins the way you do with SX. Samplitude seems to be optimized with RME hardware, so it runs very well on my system. It may not be as efficient with Lynx or others, b
