I have found that the 8 in convertors are better in either format than the other interfaces (unless you use high end down the adat pipe). However, if you're using something like say percussion and jam the levels down paris' throat like I do, you'll hardly notice a difference I think. Where it becomes more apparant is in vocals and acoustic instruments, and would like take quite a few tracks of build up to note problems. For instance, a dude like BT wouldn't be able to live on those convertors simply because 80-something tracks would be muddy :)
Normal earthlings however could likely hit over 18 tracks w/o noticing much.
