I advise if you want forward for the Avalon M5.

This is the most forwarding preamp to my ears, aggressive and in front not brilliant but in your face with great great bottom.
I have Great River (not the NV) with Lundahl transformers.
I only use Great river for electric instruments especially bass and el guitars.
I never use it for vocals, doesn't compliment vocals , thats my opinion of course.
The best allaround preamp is the Amek 9098 with newer (lower distortion) opa's, really really fanatstic.
But if you are looking for that "special" right in your face sound" with great bottom and not extra harmonics (like 9098) but with great bottom then Avalon is what I would go for.
Anyway , rent one and try before you buy.
Don't buy before trying anything based on what we say.
