That's the funniest thing I've seen in a long time. I actually had to gather the family around to appreciate that with me.

CLI would just track through the 24". Feed everything into it when you track, then take the signal straight off the playback heads (not the sync heads) and record that to your DAW as you track. Tape rapidly loses highs as the particles realign to their original positions. The best possible sound from the tape is to immediately take it off the playback heads. You will have a delay from them, but you can handle that easily enough. So you are essentially using the tape as a processor.
