I have used this card as a VST System Link carrier on a PC running Nuendo 1.6, connected to another PC running Nuendo 3, using the ADAT ports of a MOTU 828 II, and it worked perfectly, if that helps any. Like I said previously, there are only 2 TOSlink connectors on this card, but the driver/control panel allows for internal sync, or sync to ADAT input, if necessary.
