So here's a given scenario: 3 cards, 3 Busses, 2 MECs. Buss-1 says "A" Buss-2 says "B" Buss-3 Says "C" Now BUSS 1 has an MEC and Buss 2 has the second MEC. You're saying that Buss 1 and 2 will record simultaneously but Bus 3 can only be playback (because it does have a card), therefore doesn't need to be updated?
