There are a few others that would well but these are the ones that I liked most for sound quality.

If you don't absolutely need it to be fire wire or USB then I'd go for the EMU PCI cards. Lots of value with their sound cards.

Delay compensation, quality midi and VSTi, and better editing and production capabilities in general (post features, etc) have been key for me. Paris' converters were good at the time, but there are a lot of great options now in a similar price range that supercede them in varying degrees.

Imho, sound does come down to technique and approach - the capabilities are there with most DAWs now - it's just a matter of learning the differences and making them work for you, rather than working against them expecting something else. Feel free to email me offline if you want since this may not be of as much interest to Paris users here.

I also use MIDI in a BIG way and that was another key factor for the switch. I've used Cubase since my Atari 520ST days so the switch was pretty painless for me.
