> This is still a debug edition, but I have removed a lot of the debug code
> and tightened up the timeouts so that it loads quicker and uses a lot less
> CPU while running.
>
> I would be very grateful to anyone who tries this out on any PC. I haven't
> managed to make PARIS run on a multi-CPU machine reliably, but I cleaned
> up a lot of code, and this edition runs on my Phenom 9350 as long as the
> intaffnity and toms hardware utilities are used to force the driver and the
> app to cpu 4. The original XP release did not work on my Phenom no matter
> what, so this is still a very important update for me. :)
>
> I'm going to shift gears to the Mac plugs as soon as I can get the rest of
> the debug code out. Please let me know if you have any trouble before then.:)
>

> This message has one or more attachments. Select "Save Attachments"
> from the File menu to save. I'm starting to create some presets for the DP plugins Mike's been
porting. I know that many favor "rolling your own" but sometimes it's
good to at least have a starting place - particularly when a plugin has
many parameters or has odd non-linear goodies to take advantage of.

So I threw a dozen I tweaked up into a ppj (some derived from Logic's
Platinum Verb and some came from just messing about with the
parameters) and put it on the Wiki as a starting place. My monitoring
situation is far from ideal until I get into a properly treated room in
January but they'll at least serve as a "proof of concept" for the
downloads mechanism at the Wiki until I have time to tackle it properly.
