A few months ago I bought a Virtua Via PCIe to PCI expansion chassis for my new MacPro 8x3GHz to run my PCI UAD cards.

The reason why the VV box doesn't work properly with more than one UAD cards is because of a weak powersupply. The included external PSU delivers 12V/3A and unfortunately the maximum rating of the internal (on the card) 5V step-down switching regulator (2596) is also limited to 3A.
