AAI must say the truth really can be different when reading this. I took a research and found out that a fiberoptical cable can handle up to that kind of speed in tests, as they had done with that old lady in Karlstad. But the speed on their internet for the people is yet totally different. I went to

their homesite in Karlstad, Sweden, <http://www.elnat.karlstad.se/> trying to find out more. So I found out the speed for the people/firms can be up to 100 Mbit/sec up and download but normally is 10/10 Mbit/sec, after what you will pay for.

We have had this kind of fiberoptical cable here in the district for some years now and my children have used it privately from the start with 10/10 Mbit/sec and they can get up to 50/25Mbit/sec speed if they want to pay for that kind of speed. They also have TV and telephone on the same cable. Firms can allready get up to 100/100, so you see it's not any news at all;-)

copy of Giga Solo makes it a pretty unbelievable deal at around \$400.
I'm currently using a M Audio Audiophile FW interface, and it's been dead
solid on that rig at 1.5mS/44.1, so I think my chances are pretty decent. I
noted in the 1084 manual I can essentially shut off inputs and cut my over
head. Another veeeery cool trick I picked up was the one to do with FW and
WinXP SP2 being throttled back incorrectly. I'm hoping I don't have to go
there so I'll try it 'as is' first, but it gives me some options along with
double dawg. Laptop/Tablet machines aren't notorious for great bus
bandwidth, so I may get a bit of a challenge.

Also being the Dice II, I might have a harder look at the universal or ideal
driver we talked about earlier in the week. 1804 isn't listed in the 'known
to work' on the CEntrance site, but I have a strong suspicion that it'll
pick up the unit based on the Dice II chip, and that the DM3200 is on that
list... could be wrong, have you tried it?

EdnaHey Lamont - my rig only goes online to grab updates to audio apps,
registration/response codes (which is getting annoying), but never a problem
with that. But even on the net PC that's online all day with email, Skype,
etc, never had a virus, spyware, or malware. If OSX would only stop spam
mail from being sent (not filtered, but shot down at the source via a large
burst of electricity designed to fry any and all spammer computers, Apple
would really have something.... ;-)

Let me know how Nuendo runs on your new Mac though, seriously. You'll have
to wait for N4 to run on the dual core 2 Mac under OSX at least (should be
soon). I would be most interested in a head to head comparison of plugin
counts in the same project under Nuendo, not just similar projects, but

identical.

The last report I read comparing XP to OSX for DAW performance was from Derek (used to be on this NG) - German Keyboards compared them and apparently (I don't read German to confirm) XP won on plugin count and low latency by a noticeable margin on the same hardware (even when run on the same system as OSX via Bootcamp). He said even Logic ran better outside OSX, but I'm not sure how that comparison was made since Logic 5 (Win) and Logic 7 (OSX) might not be comparable. If OSX was a standalone OS, I would buy it to have both and compare, but the fastest processing, lowest bloat-factor OS would inevitably be the DAW system of choice for me.
