I had something similar a month ago and found out that the patchbay had switched to -10 unbalanced without asking me to do so:-) I think you shall have a look at the cables too, since I think my problem must be there, to see if there's some problems with one of the balanced cables. Another reason can be, if the compressor is unbalanced and the cables are too near a transformator on the way to and from Paris.
