It's a really bad idea when you have a small stage and a drummer right behind her. Picks up everything around her. I personally will never touch another 87a for a typical club date... feedback and bleed aren't worth it. Gimme a larger stage or a solo/jazz gig and we'll talk. Take this advice with the fact that I use about 7000w on the mains in clubs, understanding relation to your situation.

If she's used to the sound/pattern of a N/D 257, the Beta 58 will be your best choice for least learning curve anyway. And unlike a standard 58, the Beta won't pick up everything within 15 cardiod feet of her.
